DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Use to control the house mouse, Norway Rat, and roof rat in and around dwellings, farm buildings, food service establishments, granary bins (empty), processing plants (feed, food, non-food), storage areas (feed, food, non-food).

GENERAL: Place RODENT CAKE in locations frequented by the rodents, such as tunnels, feeding areas and runways. For rats place 100-500 g. of bait per station. For mice set out about 50 g of bait at intervals of 2-3 m. Maintain an uninterrupted supply until feeding ceases.

SEWERS: Secure by wire to the bottom step of the manhole benching. In sewers with no benching, secure block to wire, and attach the other end of the wire to the manhole ladder, keeping the block above water level. In storm sewers, suspend block from grate, so that it remains a few inches above normal water level.

Maintain an uninterrupted supply until feeding ceases. RODENT CAKE should always be secured with wire.

CAUTIONS: Keep out of reach of children. If taken in large or repeated doses by humans or animals, it may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause internal bleeding. Place bait in protected places inaccessible to children and domestic animals or in tamper-proof bait boxes. Do not contaminate food or feed. Do not contaminate any body of water. Burn the bodies of dead rodents.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING

FIRST AID: If swallowed give patient one or two glasses of water and cause vomiting by inserting finger down throat; repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician,

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Blood transfusions combined with intravenous injections and oral doses of vitamin K1 are indicated, as for hemorrhage by overdose of dicumarol.
