DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Use bait to control the Norway rat (*Rattus norvegicus*), Roof rat (*Rattus rattus*) and House mouse (*Mus musculus*) in and around dwellings.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats and/or mice most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been observed. Remove as much food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

RATS: Apply 2 to 8 Quintox Rat & Mouse Bait place pacs at intervals of 4 to 6 m per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

HOUSE MICE: Place Quintox Rat & Mouse Bait place pacs at intervals of 2-4 m per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

RATS/MICE: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of unconsumed bait and dead exposed animals. To prevent reinfestation, eliminate food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment.

Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN, PETS, DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND WILDLIFE. Do not expose treated bait in areas accessible to children, dogs, domestic animals and wildlife except when enclosed within a tamper-resistant bait box. If swallowed, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash arms, hands and face with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or feed, or surfaces that come direct contact with food or feed.

FIRST AID: If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes. If on skin, wash with soap and water. If swallowed, give patient one or two glasses of water and INDUCE VOMITING by touching back of throat with a finger or blunt object; repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Contact a physician or Poison Control Centre IMMEDIATELY. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: If serum calcium levels are elevated, treatment with calcitonin is effective in reducing calcium to normal levels. Continue monitoring serum calcium and treat as necessary for hypercalcemia.

STORAGE: Store only in original container in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.
