Fungus gnats are tiny, delicate flies about 3 mm long. The gnats themselves are only a nuisance, indicating the presence of maggots, likely in the soil of potted plants. The maggots cause injury by feeding on the roots and crowns of plants. Injured plants grow poorly, appear off-colour and may drop leaves.

DIRECTIONS: If possible, remove plants out-of-doors for treatment. Apply dust lightly to soil around plant. Repeat as needed but no more than once every 2 months.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not allow dust to contact food, food preparing surfaces, utensils or drinking water. Wash contaminated food surfaces and utensils with soap and water. May cause irritation to skin or eyes; avoid contact. Avoid inhaling dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using. Avoid contaminations of ornamental fish ponds and fish bowls. Dispose of the container with regular garbage.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, induce vomiting and seek medical attention. Flush contaminated eyes and skin with plenty of water. For eyes, get prompt medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine by injection only is an antidote.
