This product has an effective range up to 5.5 metres (18 feet). The canister empties in approximately 8 seconds.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**: Special procedures must be followed to arm the container, apply the product and restore the safety clip to disarm the container. Before taking this product into bear country, read the directions below and familiarise yourself with these procedures. If you test-fire this container, make sure to discharge downwind and do not depress the actuator tab for more than one-half a second. Do not test-fire in areas inhabited by bears. After test firing, clean nozzle and can with soap and water to remove all residues from the can.

**TO ARM AND APPLY:** This product is designed for one-hand operation. Place forefinger through hole in handle, with thumb on orange safety clip curl. Pull safety clip straight back and off using thumb (Figure 1). Depress actuator tab for burst of spray (Figure 2).

Aim at the face and eyes of bear. Press trigger for 3 seconds in order to create a barrier of spray between you and the bear. Stop to evaluate the impact of wind and other factors and adjust your aim if needed before spraying again. The maximum effective range is 5.5 metres (18 feet). Spray is most effective at short range. Avoid discharging upwind and, after discharging, move away to avoid exposure to spray.

TO DISARM: Replace orange safety clip by firmly pushing with thumb until audible "snap" is heard (Figure 3).

Check to see if safety clip is securely in place. No gap should be visible between the actuator handle and the safety clip.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Capsaicin sprays have been proven effective in repelling bears only when sprayed directly in the eyes or on the nose. This product should be used only as a last resort. There is no guaranteed method of responding to a bear encounter, each encounter is unique.
