DIRECTIONS:

To Clean and Disinfect: All water washable, hard, non food contact surfaces, dilute 12 mL of **Pine Disinfectant Detergent** per litre of water (1:80). Apply to surface, scrub, allow 10 minutes before rinsing with clean water.

To Clean and Disinfect critical areas: All water washable, hard, non food contact surfaces, dilute 25 mL of **Pine Disinfectant Detergent** per litre of water (1:40). Apply to surface, scrub, allow 10 minutes before rinsing with clean water.

PRECAUTIONS. Keep out of the reach of children. Do not contaminate food or food contact surfaces. Do not use on animals. Do not expose to skin for prolonged periods.

FIRST AID:

Eyes: Immediately flush with plenty of cool running water. Remove contact lenses. Continue flushing for at least 15 minutes holding eyelids apart to ensure rinsing of the entire eye.

Skin: Immediately flush with plenty of cool running water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

If swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth immediately, then drink one or two glasses of water or milk. **Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.**

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
