FOR AGRICULTURE USE -

Dairy farms - clean equipment prior to sanitizing with Drayton DCI. For utensils and equipment rinse with 2 ml per litre (1/3 oz per gallon) 200 ppm solution for approximately 2 minutes.

For sanitizing pipelines a 2 ml per litre (1/3 oz per gallon) 200 ppm solution of Drayton DCI for 2 minutes.

No potable water rinse required if solution does not exceed 200 ppm. Potable water rinse is required to a concentration exceeding 200 ppm available chlorine.

FOR SWIMMING POOLS -

For wading pools add 5 mL for every 250 1 of water. Recommended for use in all types of pools - vinyl lined, concrete and fibre glass. Before adding Drayton DCI, the pH should be tested and adjusted within 7.2 to 7.6. Add muriatic acid if pH is high. Add soda ash if pH is low. Drayton DCI should be added daily to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 parts per million available chlorine. The use of a test kit is recommended, as the air temperature and the number of people in the pool will affect the amount of Drayton DCI required. Under average conditions, Drayton DCI should be added daily to pool water according to the following chlorination guide.

Pool Capacity [litres]	Daily Charge [litres]
10,000	125 - 250 m1
20,000 50,000	325 - 625 ml 625 ml - 1.25 L
100,000	1.25 - 2.50 L
250,000	3.25 - 6.25 L

NOTE: First application should be double the indicated amount. Every three weeks, add one week's charge of Mall DCI in one application to ensure proper control of algae, slime and fungus. Avoid using pool until chlorine residual drops below 2.0 ppm (approximately 24 hours).

FIRST AID TREATMENT: Contains Sodium Hypochlorite. If splashed in eyes or on skin, flush thoroughly with water. If swallowed, give one or two glasses of milk or warm water. Call physician immediately. Keep patient warm.
