DIRECTIONS: Recochem's Creosote Oil can be applied by brushing or dipping. Maximum penetration is obtained on properly seasoned surface dry lumber. All bark should be removed. If the treated wood is to be used in contact with the ground, or is to be subject to other severe decay hazards, two or more applications

of preservative should be made. Dipping or preferably soaking is recommended wherever possible to secure maximum penetration and protection. It is not recommended to paint over Creosote Oil as bleeding might occur. Do not apply by spraying.

Do not use on surfaces which may come into contact with the body, as Creosote Oil may irritate sensitive skin. For exterior use only. Not for use in dwellings. Do not use Creosote treated wood in residential or farm building interiors. Do not apply to wood where domestic animals or livestock are likely to crib or lick the wood, or where the wood may come in contact with food or animal feed. Do not use Creosote on wood in direct contact with drinking water, on children's playground equipment, on greenhouse or horticulture lumber, or on wharfs and docks where contamination of open water may occur.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May cause chemical burns to skin and eyes. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Wear appropriate gloves, long sleeved clothing (i.e. made from Neoprene) and goggles when applying. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using. Do not use near plants. This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of wastes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after exposure and before eating, drinking, smoking or using a rest room.
