Treat at night or late evening when insects are inside the nest. Apply spray with 2-3 second bursts directly into the nest opening so that the liquid contacts the inside of the nest. If unable to spray directly into the nest, a heavy residual spray around and into openings where insects gain entrance will eventually eliminate the pests. Repeat as necessary.
