GENERAL INFORMATION :

Even a well-maintained house still contains dust that is favourable to the development of undesirable pests. These mites feed on detaching debris from the human skin. They are most abundant in bedrooms, bedding, fabric, also on the floor and in cracks.

These mites, dead or alive and their excrement can cause a great number of allergies : more than half the cases of asthma, rhinitis and spasmodic coughs, mainly in children, teenagers and young adults.

Allergic conjunctivitis, skin diseases (atopic eczema, prurigo, hives ...) can be attributed in part or totally to certain mites.

The prevention of allergy symptoms relies on the battle against dust and the elimination of mites.

To fight house dust, you must :

Vacuum every day in the room when the allergic patient is absent. Change sheets and pillow cases every week. Wash blankets every 2 months. Reduce the amount of furniture and fabric in the room, eliminate if possible, curtains, carpets and rugs. Exclude all toys made of plush or fabric.

To eliminate the mites :

ACARDUST, a synthetic pyrethroid combined with a synergist, will not only destroy adult mites, but also stop the development of their eggs and nymphs. Spray once every three months, and it will be sufficient to fight against reinfestation of the bedding by new mites coming from outside.

Manual application of spray on bedding and base boards; windows should be open.
