USE DIRECTIONS

FOR CLEANING

Lightly soiled areas - surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 30 mL of GERMENE per litre of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

Heavily soiled areas - mop or brush soiled surface with a solution containing 45 mL of GERMENE per litre of water. Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in schools, restaurants, rest rooms and other public areas, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 30 mL of GERMENE per litre of water. Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned with 15 mL of GERMENE per litre of water and then disinfected. Those surfaces which may later come in contact with food must be rinsed with clear water of drinking quality. To disinfect locker rooms, shower stalls, walkways around pools and other areas against pathogenic fungi, mop area with a solution containing 15 mL in 1 litre of water. This solution will destroy Trichophyton interdigitale, a causative agent of athlete's foot.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 15 mL of GERMENE per litre of water. Those surfaces that are heavily soiled with blood, faecal material or exudates should be thoroughly scrubbed with a solution containing 15 mL per litre of water and then rinsed with a fresh solution containing 15 mL per litre of water before disinfection.

SANITIZATION

To sanitize walls, floors and equipment in food processing plants first clean thoroughly with a solution containing 30 mL of GERMENE per litre of water. If surface is heavily soiled, use GERMENE at a rate of 45 mL per litre to insure thorough cleaning. Sanitize cleaned surface with a rinse solution containing 15 mL of GERMENE per litre of water.

DEODORIZATION

To deodorize surfaces during cleaning, mop or brush surfaces with a solution containing 60 mL of GERMENE per litre of water.

GERMENE is an effective antibacterial cleaner designed for use in industrial and institutional cleaning. When used as directed, GERMENE will disinfect hard surfaces garbage pails, food storage areas, kennel areas and other areas where obnoxious odors may develop. This product may be used as a general purpose antibacterial detergent in schools, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes, public rooms, and Food Processing Plants where efficient cleaning and antimicrobial action is desired.

PRECAUTIONS

Rinse surfaces which have been sprayed with potable water before re-use.
