SUPER 40 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness, pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using SUPER 40.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 100 mL of SUPER 40 per 10,000 L of pool water.
2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 35 mL per 10,000 L.
3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.

4. For visible algae, when superchlorination product is not employed, add 150 ml of SUPER 40 per 10,000 L.

PRECAUTIONS:

Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if swallowed. Do not mix with any other chemical. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Rinse container thoroughly before discarding. Do not reuse. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills, contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact with eyes or skin, flush thoroughly with water for 15 minutes. For eye contact, get medical attention. If swallowed, drink 2 or 3 glasses of milk or water. Call a physician or Poison Control Centre IMMEDIATELY.
