Proper use of Clearwater products will help you avoid pool problems.

Prevent algae forming by treating your pool with ALGIRID when first filling and maintain regular weekly treatment thereafter.

ALGIRID is not affected by sunlight and will reduce chlorine consumption, allow longer filter runs and give a softer feel to pool water.

DIRECTIONS: Indoor pools require only half the following amounts. Outdoor pools: Once only, on first filling, pools require 200 mL ALGIRID per 10,000 litres water. Thereafter, add regularly each week 50 mL ALGIRID per 10,000 litres water.

HEAVY ALGAE requires PROMPT SHOCK TREATMENT by adding 400 mL ALGIRID per 10,000 litres water then allow a 1 - 2 day rest period (no swimming or stirring) followed by vigorous brushing of sides and bottom to loosen all dead algae. Let it settle then thoroughly vacuum residue from bottom.
