DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Wipe-on method for Horses: Apply with a cloth which is slightly moistened with the product. Use 30-60 mL for an adult horse. Repeat daily or as necessary but not more often than once a day.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Do not use on horses intended for slaughter. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Wash after using. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Do not contaminate feed, food or litter. Do not contaminate food-handling equipment. Store in original container away from feed and food. Do not contaminate any body of water.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Highly toxic to crabs, fish and shrimps. Do not apply this product directly to aquatic habitats (such as lakes, rivers, sloughs, ponds, prairie potholes, creeks, marshes, streams, reservoirs, ditches and wetlands), estuaries or marine habitat. This product contains a petroleum distillate which is moderately to highly toxic to aquatic organisms. Avoid contamination of aquatic systems during application. Do not contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies, or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DISPOSAL:

Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank. Follow provincial instruction for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use. Dispose of the container in

accordance with provincial requirements. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.

FIRST AID: If swallowed: call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give **any** liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If in eyes: hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
