#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Shake well before using. Point valve opening away from face and push button, holding can upright.

#### FLYING INSECTS:

To control flies, gnats, mosquitoes, and wasps—Close doors and windows. Direct mist upwards to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources. Spray 6–11 seconds per 30 m<sup>3</sup> of space. For best results leave the room closed for 15 minutes after each treatment and before ventilation. Also direct mist into areas where insects are present. Keep spray at least 1 m from interior walls, fabrics and furniture.

#### CRAWLING INSECTS:

To control cockroaches, ants and silverfish: Spray hiding places such as baseboards, moist areas, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, behind cabinets and storage area. Spray ant trail around door sills and window frames, or in ant nests. Insects must be contacted to be killed.

#### BED BUGS:

Spray mattress, especially around seams and tufts. Take beds apart, spray all joints. Repeat as required.

Ensure proper ventilation after sealed areas have been treated.

#### PRECAUTIONS:

Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat. Do not incinerate can or store at temperatures over 50°C. Flammable mixture. Product contains petroleum distillate. Do not spray into or near fire or open flame. Do not remain in treated areas. Do not spray directly on food or utensils. Remove fish bowls and bird cages before spraying. Do not spray closer than 1 m to fabric. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin: avoid contact with skin, eyes, clothing and inhalation of spray mist. Wash hands after use. In food processing plants and food service establishments, apply only when the plant is not in operation. Cover all food processing surfaces and thoroughly clean with potable water before resuming operation. In dwellings, remove or cover all exposed food and cooking utensils before spraying. Keep out of reach of children. Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined.

DISPOSAL:

Dispose of container in regular garbage.
