This product has been tested by AOAC XII Use-Dilution Test and is effective at a dilution of 20mL/L against Salmonella choleraesuis ATCC No. 10708, Salmonella typhosa ATCC No. 6539, and Staphylococcus aureus ATCC No. 6538.

DIRECTIONS:

To disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces of bathrooms, shower stalls, stables, garbage receptacles, etc. dilute 20 mL/L of warm water. Allow 10 minutes contact time. Rinse well after use.
