DIRECTIONS: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Hold can upright while spraying.

TO KILL HOUSE PESTS:

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, wasps, biting midges and flying moths. Close doors and windows. Direct mist upwards in sweeping motion to all parts of the room especially windows and

other light sources. Apply 6-10 seconds burst per 30 m³ of space. Whenever possible, keep doors and windows closed for 15 minutes after each treatment. Also direct mist into areas where insects are present. Keep spray at least 1 m from interior wall, fabrics and furniture. Ensure proper ventilation after sealed areas have been treated and clean up dead insects.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Cockroaches, spiders, crickets, ants, carpet beetles, centipedes and silverfish. Spray hiding places such as baseboards, moist areas, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, behind cabinets and storage areas. Spray ant trails, around door sills, window frames, or in ant nests. Insects must be hit to be killed.

BED BUGS: Spray mattress lightly, particularly around seams and tufts. Take beds apart, spray the frame and springs including all joints. Repeat as required.

TO CONTROL FLEAS: Spray infested areas such as pet's bed and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Remove old bedding after treatment. Insects must be contacted to be killed. Do not treat animals with this product.

TO KILL GARDEN PESTS: ON FLOWERS AND ORNAMENTALS

SUCKING INSECTS: Exposed thrips, leafhoppers, spotted mites, lace bugs, aphids.

CHEWING INSECTS: Caterpillars, climbing cutworms, Japanese Beetles. For insects on Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Gladiolas, Irises, Marigolds, Petunias, Roses and Snapdragons, Evergreens, small Deciduous trees, Shrubs and Vines. Carefully spray with slow sweeping motion keeping 30cm to 45cm away from the plants to avoid wetting the foliage. A light spray kills pests effectively. Spray only when air is still and temperature is under 32°C. Do not spray in direct sunlight, early morning or evening preferred. Use with caution on young plants and new growth. Insects must be contacted by spray to be killed.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat, or store at temperatures over 50°C. Cover fish bowls and remove pets for one hour when spraying rooms. In homes or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed foods and cooking utensils before spraying. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Wash after using. Keep from freezing. Do not use on Maiden Hair ferns. Do not use on

vegetable crops.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press button to release all pressure then dispose in household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.

FIRST AID: In case of contact with eyes or skin, flush with water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention. If accidentally swallowed, contact physician or poison control centre.
