## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

Reapply to non-combat military clothing after six weeks of wear or after every sixth laundering, whichever is sooner. Under appropriate military direction, dry cleaning can be used to remove permethrin from treated clothing or mosquito nets.

To achieve maximum protection against biting insects, this item needs to be used with other insect discipline measures, for example with a topical repellent applied to exposed skin areas.
