#### PRECAUTIONS

Keep out of reach of children.

## FIRST AID

If splashed in eyes or on skin, flush thoroughly with water for 15 minutes. For eye contact, get medical attention. If swallowed, drink 2 or 3 glasses of milk or water. Call a Physician IMMEDIATELY.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 200 mL of Algaecide per 10,000 L of pool water.
2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 100 mL per 10,000 L.
3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate new statement and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
4. For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 500 mL of Algaecide per 10,000 L. When algae have turned brown, brush the walls of the pool and remove the dead algae by vacuum and filtering. Backwash the filter as needed.
5. To ensure sparkling, healthy, algae-free water, test the residual chlorine content daily and maintain at 1 ppm.
