DIRECTIONS FOR USE: All organic matter should be cleaned from equipment wherever possible (farrowing crates, creep feeders, layer cages, drinking troughs and bowls, etc.) and Citadel Germ Kill applied with a brush in a concentration of 50 ppm available iodine (3 ml/litre water). Do not use extremely hot water. For porous surfaces or surfaces difficult to clean, the concentration may be increased to 75 ppm (5 ml/litre water).

For floors and walls, use 75 ppm (5 ml/litre water). Citadel Germ Kill may be brushed on or applied with a sprayer. Care should be taken to ensure that all surfaces are covered - floors, walls, and all rafters or beams in the ceiling. For foot baths use 100 ppm (6 ml/litre water).
