DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Apply by metered pump. To control bacterial and fungal growth on paper and paperboard machines NALCON 7677 is added to the white water or stock at 0.05 to 0.5 kg/tonne of dry paper or paperboard produced. For mold resistant paper or paperboard NALCON 7677 is used at 2.44 to 7.32 kg/1000m<sup>2</sup> of surface. For coated paper or board NALCON 7677 is incorporated in the coating mix prior to application of the coating. For uncoated paper or board NALCON 7677 is dispersed in water, surface sizing solution, or other solvent and applied to the surface to be protected by means of an applicator roll.

USE RESTRICTION: Not for use in the manufacture of paper or paperboard used for food packaging.

PRECAUTIONS: NALCON 7677 is corrosive and causes severe eye injury and skin irritation and is harmful if swallowed. Can cause dermal sensitization. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly after handling.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries or public waters. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Apply this pesticide only as specified on this label.

FIRST AID: Wash skin with soap and water for at least 15 minutes. In case of eye contact, flush with water and get immediate medical attention. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting.
