DIRECTIONS FOR USE

MIXING DIRECTIONS: Fill your spray tank half full of water, then add 2,4-D ESTER 500 at the rates given below, and finally add the balance of water. When mixing 2,4-D ESTER 500 with oil, add the chemical to the oil and THOROUGHLY agitate or shake for several minutes.

LAWN & TURF WEED CONTROL: Use 2.4 - 3 L of 2,4-D ESTER 500 per 2000 L of water to cover 1 ha. If lawns begin to brown, water heavily. Use the lower rates under rapid growing conditions, or on hot dry days, or in a dry climate. Do not use on newly seeded

lawns, bent grasses, or when there is any danger of drift. Do not spray for several days after mowing.

HARDY WEEDS: such as Morning glory, Thistle, etc. - use at the rate of 50~mL/10~L of water and spray plants to the point of run-off. Treat weeds when actively growing.

WOOD GROWTH OR BRUSH: Use 100 mL per 10 L of water and spray to the point of run-off. Be sure to obtain complete coverage. Repeat application if necessary. Spray when plants are tender and actively growing, and under 2.5 m in height.

STUMP KILLING: Use 2,4-D ESTER 500 at the rate of 30 mL-40 mL/L of water, kerosene, or strained waste oil. Spray stumps and any exposed parts of roots thoroughly. Be sure to obtain complete coverage. Apply with a brush or sprayer. For 2,4-D resistant species, such as Common blackberry, Hawthorn, Lambkill, Lilac, Maple, Wild currant, Wild rose - use DIPHENOPROP BK 700. Refer to local agricultural authorities.

CEREALS: Barley, Bye, Wheat (not underseeded to legumes): Use 2,4-D ESTER 500 at the rate of 0.6 L - 1.2 L with sufficient water to give complete coverage of 1 ha. Use higher rates for more resistant weeds, heavy weed infestations, or under cool weather conditions. Spray at the 3-leaf stage of growth. Do not spray growth underseeded to legumes unless certain damage to legumes can be tolerated.

OATS: Oats are more sensitive to 2,4-D ESTER 500 and great care should be taken if this crop has to be sprayed. Use at the rate of 0.6 L/1 ha. Apply when the oats are between the 3-leaf and flag-leaf stage. Do not apply after the flag-leaf stage.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. PRECAUTIONS: Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye irritation, may cause skin irritation. Wash well after using. Do not apply in the vicinity of desirable susceptible plants. not use around desirable shrubs or trees or on areas where run-off may affect plants. Do not allow spray, spray mist, visible or invisible vapours, or air containing mist or vapours to contact susceptible plants. Do not permit spray, or air containing spray mist to contact susceptible plants as even minute quantities may cause damage to plants during both the growing or dormant period. For aerial application exercise special care: 1) Do not spray in winds exceeding 8 kmph. 2) Do not spray in dead calm near sensitive plants. Do not mix with liquid fertilizers containing liquid nitrogen. Do not contaminate any body of water. Do not contaminate foods or feeds. Do not store near foods, feeds, seeds, fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides, herbicides or other pesticides other than those containing 2,4-D. Wash equipment thoroughly after use. Do not use the same sprayer for other susceptible crops. Do not re-use empty container.
