Repeat in 7-10 days if necessary. Earwigs - 45 ml/litre. Apply on infested area. Leatherjackets (Crane Flies) - Mix 6 ml/litre water and apply 5 litres on 10 m2 to short grass from October to March. Repeat in 7-10 days if necessary. White Grubs (such as European Chafer and Japanese Beetle Larvae) -Apply 500 ml/100 m2 of lawn in sufficient water to provide good coverage. Water grass thoroughly after application. Apply anytime between late July and early October.
