## PULP AND PAPER MILLS

### DIRECTIONS:

Point of Addition: Process B-2008 should be added at a point in the system where it will be uniformly mixed. Application may be continuous or intermittent for a certain number of hours per day or per shift, depending upon system characteristics. Add 65 to 160 mL of Process B-2008 per metric ton of paper produced.

Intermittent Feed Method: Apply 115 to 160 mL of Process B-2008 per metric ton (dry basis) of pulp or paper for 2 hours every 8 hours. Badly fouled systems should be cleaned before initial treatment.

Continuous Feed Method: Apply 65 TO 130 mL of Process B-2008 per metric ton (dry basis) of pulp or paper produced on a continuous basis. Badly fouled systems should be cleaned before initial treatment.

Warning: This product is not to be used in the production of paper or paperboard that comes into contact with food.

### PRECAUTIONS:

DANGER - CORROSIVE TO EYES. CORROSIVE TO SKIN.

POTENTIAL SKIN SENSITIZER.

HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED.

Do not get in eyes, on skin, on clothing. Wear chemical resistant gloves, goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid breathing vapour or mist. Use with adequate ventilation. Do not swallow. Wash hands after use and before eating, drinking or smoking. Avoid contamination of food, feed or drinking water by storage or disposal. May form hazardous vapours on contact with water. Do not spray the product in open systems. Keep container closed.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

This product is highly toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain

**Eye Contact:** Immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Hold eyelids apart during the flushing to ensure rinsing of the entire surface of the eye and lids with water. Get medical attention.

**Skin Contact:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

**Inhalation:** Remove immediately to fresh air. If not breathing, administer artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, administer oxygen. Call a physician.

**Ingestion:** DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. Call a physician or Poison Control Centre immediately.
