DIRECTIONS: To control root maggots and other vegetable insects, follow directions on the table below. On sandy soil, about 1 cm of soil should cove the insecticide in seed furrow and separate the seed from the chemical; otherwise, damage to the vegetable crop may result. The treatment must be applied uniformly in the seed row.

CROP	INSECT PESTS	RATE PER 10 METRES OF ROW LENGTH	METHOD
Onions	Onion Maggot	15 g	Apply in seed furrow at planting time.

Radishes	Root Maggot	20 g	Apply in seed furrow at planting time.
Turnips	Root Maggot	45 g	Apply as above. Two weeks after thinning make a second application in a narrow band directly above the row.
Cabbage Cauliflower Broccoli and Brussel Sprouts in Seed Beds.	Root Maggot	20 g	Apply in seed furrow at planting time.
Transplants of above crops listed	Root Maggots	80 g per 10 metres or 15 g per plant	Apply to the soil in a 10 cm radius around the stem of each individual plant soon after transplanting.
Corn	Corn Root Worm	25 g	Apply in 20 cm band over the row at planting time.
Carrots and Parsnips	Carrot Rust Fly Larvae.	10 g	Apply in seed furrow at planting time.
Gardens	Cutworms	500 g per 100 m 2	Spread over soil surface just before planting. Mix into the top 8-16 cm of soil.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May be fatal if swallowed. May absorbed through the skin. Avoid contract with skin and eyes. Wash thorough after handling. Avoid contamination of feed and food stuffs.

## FIRST AID:

- 1. In case of poisoning call a physician or contact a poison control centre immediately.

- 3. If in eyes, flush with water immediately and continue for 5-10 minutes.
