DIRECTIONS:

CROP AND INSECT	AMOUNT TO USE PER LITRE	TIMING
Apple: European Red Mite, Lecanium Scale, San Jose Scale, European Fruit Sale, Red Banded Leaf Roller	20 mL	Green tip* to 1 cm Green
Pear: European Red Mite, Pear Psyllia, Scale Insects	20 mL	Dormant * to Green Tip*

*Dormant - before buds have swollen or expanded *Green Tip - fruit buds broken at tip and showing about 2 mm of new green tissue. *1 cm Green - 1 cm of new green tissue projecting from fruit buds.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS: Use only a clean sprayer. Do not use a sprayer that was previously used to apply herbicides. To mix, add 1 litre of water to sprayer. Pour in the amount of DORMANT OIL required and mix. The mixture should turn white. If it does not turn white (emulsify), do not use. Return product to dealer. After mixing, fill sprayer. Apply enough spray to each tree to soak the bark completely. Do not over spray.

PRECAUTIONS: DO NOT USE DORMANT OIL on Red Delicious apples. Do not mix DORMANT OIL and ANY other products. Do not apply other products to the fruit tree seven days before or after the application of DORMANT OIL. Do not spray during or prior to freezing temperatures. Do not spray later than recommended. Injury can occur if fruit trees are in poor condition, weather conditions are adverse or over spraying has taken place. KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not contaminate streams, lakes, ponds and irrigation water. Keep away from fire, open flame, heat sources or sparks. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

FIRST AID:

1. In case of poisoning call a physician or contact a poison control centre immediately.
2. If on skin, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water.
3. If in eyes, flush with water immediately and continue for 5-10 minutes. Get medical attention or contact a poison control centre.
4. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting then take patient to nearest hospital or doctor's office or contact a poison control centre. Take the pesticide label with you.

DISPOSAL:

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and discard in household garbage.
