POTATOES: Apply 1 kg of dust per 100 kg of potato seed pieces for the control of Fusarium Seed Piece Decay. Apply thoroughly to coat the surface of whole or cut seed pieces with dust. If treated whole seed is cut, make a second application to protect the cut surface. Plant as soon as possible after treatment. If cut seed is not planted immediately, store in a well ventilated location to permit cut surface to dry. Do not use surplus treated seed pieces for food or feed.
