DIRECTIONS:

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Hold can upright while spraying.

TO KILL HOUSE PESTS:

"Flying Insects" - Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Gnats and Flying Moths. Close doors and windows. Direct mist upwards in sweeping motion to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources. Apply 6-10 seconds burst per 30 m<sup>3</sup> of space.

Whenever possible, keep doors and windows closed for 15 minutes after each treatment. Also direct mist into areas where insects are present. Keep spray at least 1 metre from interior wall, fabrics and furniture.

"Crawling Insects" - Cockroaches, spiders, crickets, ants, carpet beetles, centipedes and silverfish. Spray hiding places such as baseboards, moist areas, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, behind cabinets and storage areas. Spray ant trails, around door sills, window frames, or in ant nests. Insect must be hit to be killed.

Dog & Cat Fleas, Brown Dog Tick & American Dog Tick. Lightly spray sleeping quarters of pets, cracks, crevices, baseboards, underneath furniture, localized areas of floors and floor covering where the pet frequents. Repeat spraying as required. DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT ON PETS.

TO KILL GARDEN PESTS ON FLOWERS AND ORNAMENTALS:

Sucking Insects - Exposed thrips, leafhoppers, spotted mites, lace bugs, aphids. Chewing Insects - Caterpillars, climbing cutworms, Japanese beetles. For insects on asters, azaleas, begonias chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, gladiolae, irises, marigolds, petunias, roses and snapdragons, evergreens, small deciduous trees, shrubs and vines. Carefully spray with slow sweeping motion keeping 30 cm to 45 cm away from the plants to avoid wetting the foliage. A light spray kills pests effectively. Spray only when air is still and temperature is under 32'C. Do not spray in direct sunlight, early morning or evening is preferred. Use with caution on young plants and new growth. Insects must be contacted by spray to be killed.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat or store at temperatures over 50'C. Cover fish bowls and remove pets for one hour when spraying rooms. In homes or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed foods and cooking utensils before spraying. Wash food preparation surfaces prior to re-use. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Wash after using. Keep from freezing. Do not use on Maiden Hair ferns. Do not use on vegetable crops.

FIRST AID:

Avoid inhalation or exposure of concentrate to eyes or skin. In case of contact to eyes, flush with water; in case of skin contact, wash with soap and water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention. If accidentally swallowed, obtain medical attention at once.

DISPOSAL:

When container is empty, press button to release all pressure then dispose of in household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.
