GENERAL INFORMATION: Deccoquin 305 Concentrate is intended for postharvest use to prevent storage scald on susceptible varieties of apples and pears.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: To make a treating concentration of 2700 PPM ethoxyquin, add one part (by volume) of DECCOQUIN Concentrate to 200 parts of water.

Add DECCOQUIN Concentrate to the dip tank or drencher tank while filling with water and mix thoroughly. Excess foaming can be prevented by adding a small amount of silicone antifoam to the water before adding the DECCOQUIN Concentrate.

When treating Golden Delicious apples, use extreme caution. Deccoquin may cause staining.

After treatment, be sure to tip bins to drain thoroughly before placing fruit in cold storage.

DECCOQUIN, diluted to 2700 PPM ethoxyquin, can also be applied

to apples and pears as a spray on a brush bed or conveyor rolls. For best control of scald, apply to apples and pears no later than one week after harvest. Change solution daily, or more often, if needed. Avoid undue exposure of concentrate and diluted DECCOQUIN to light to avoid darkening. However, darkening does not adversely affect scald control properties of product.

CAUTION

FIRST AID:

If swallowed, induce vomiting. Call a physician or contact a poison control center.

In case of eye contact, flush eyes with water for 15 minutes and see a physician. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DISPOSAL:

1. Triple-or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.
