For use as a spot or crack and crevice treatment only to control insects listed front panel

GENERAL DIRECTIONS: Hold container approximately 30 cm. from surface being sprayed and spray until wet. Thorough applications produce a coating which will vapourize into cracks and crevices for insect control. Provide adequate ventilation during and after use. KEEP PETS AND CHILDREN AWAY FROM SURFACE UNTIL DRY. Do not use in areas where food is processed, handled, served or stored.

FOR INDOOR USE: Thoroughly treat cracks and crevices, and spots along baseboards, underneath furniture and equipment, around garbage containers, spaces around waterpipes and tanks, beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks and stoves, wherever insects are found or hide. In homes or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed food and cooking utensils before spraying. Thoroughly wash all surfaces that might contact food before reuse. Do not use in areas where food is stored.

In meat and food processing plants and food service establishments, treat only when plant is NOT in operation. Remove or cover all food packaging materials, and utensils and cover all food processing surfaces before spraying. After treatment, wash all surfaces that may contact food and rinse thoroughly with potable water before resuming operations. Do not use in rooms where milk is processed, handled or stored. Do not store or spray near open flame or stove.

FOR OUTDOOR USE: Spray outside surfaces of screens and around doors and window frames, foundations, patios, light fixtures and other places where insects may alight, or congregate and enter.

PRECAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other source of heat, or store at temperatures over 50 degrees C. Do not spray near open flame or spark. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin or clothing. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. DO NOT USE ON HUMANS, PLANTS, ANIMALS, FOOD STUFF, FOOD UTENSILS, FISHBOWLS OR ANIMAL FEED AREAS. DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press button to release all pressure, then dispose of in accordance with Provincial requirements. Do not puncture or incinerate.
