DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

CUTTING FLUID: **GAMUT** is used to control the growth of bacteria and fungi in cutting fluids.

Initial dosage: Add 1 part of **GAMUT** per 100 parts of total diluted cutting fluid weight.

Maintenance: Repeat treatment every four (4) weeks or as needed.

NOTE: Prior to the use of **GAMUT** in water cooling towers or industrial air washing systems, systems should be cleaned to remove algae growth, microbiological growth and slime, and other deposits.

COOLING TOWER SYSTEMS: Make an initial slug addition of 0.5 to 1 L of **GAMUT** per 10,000 litres of water in the system. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Make subsequent slug additions of 0.5 to 1 L of **GAMUT** per 10,000 litres of water every 1 to 5 days or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water cooling towers.

INDUSTRIAL AIR WASHING SYSTEMS: Make an additional slug addition of 150 to 225 mL of **GAMUT** per 1,000 litres of water in the system. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Make subsequent slug additions of 150 to 225 mL of **GAMUT** per 1,000 litres of water every 1 to 5 days or as needed. This frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of microbiological problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump or to the water collector trays.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Wash thoroughly after using.

DISPOSAL

1. Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product, and the cleanup of spills, contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.

FIRST AID: In case of contact: Immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. **For eyes:** Call a physician. **If swallowed:** Give doses of powdered charcoal immediately or all they can swallow of raw egg whites, gruel, or flour and water. Then induce vomiting. Call a physician or poison control centre immediately.
