Germicide-12 is an effective antibacterial product designed to be used in industrial and institutional establishments. It can be used on walls, floors, equipments, furniture and other hard surfaces.

DIRECTIONS: FOR CLEANING: Lightly soiled areas - surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 8 mL of Germicide-12 per litre of water. Rinse cleaned areas with fresh water. Heavily soiled areas - mop or brush soiled surfaces with a solution containing 20 mL per litre of water. Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSES DISINFECTION: To disinfect add 12 mL per litre of water. Surfaces that are heavily soiled should first be cleaned following the preceding instructions and then disinfected. Those surfaces which may later come in contact with food must be rinsed with potable water. To disinfect locker rooms, shower stalls, walkways around pools and other areas against pathogenic fungi, mop area with a solution containing 5 mL per litre of water. This solution will destroy Trichophyton Interdigitale, a causative agent of athlete's foot.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION: To disinfect use 20 mL of Germicide-12 per litre of water. Those surfaces that are heavily soiled with blood, fecal material or exudates should be thoroughly scrubbed with a solution containing 16 mL per litre of water and then rinsed with a fresh solution containing 16 mL per litre of solution.

SANITIZATION: Sanitize cleaned surface with a rinse solution containing 8 mL of Germicide-12 per litre of water. Food contact surfaces must be rinsed with potable water before reuse.

DEODORIZATION: To deodorize surface during cleaning, mop or brush surface with a solution containing 16 mL per litre of water. It may be relied upon to deodorize bathroom areas, garbage pails and other areas where obnoxious odours may develop.

PRECAUTIONS: Keep out of reach of children. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and call a physician. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician immediately.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.
