## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

BEEF CATTLE, HORSES, SHEEP (for PIGS see below): For lice and ticks mix 250-375 g in 200 litres of water and apply as overall spray at 4.5-9 litres per beef cow and 2.25-4.5 litres per horse or sheep; for lice repeat 14-18 days later. The same spray may be used for hornflies on beef only by spraying back and shoulders at 1-2 litres per cow.

For dip-treatment of sheep mix 625 g in 1000 litres of water.

For lice and mangemites on PIGS use 410 g per 200 litres of water and apply as an overall spray at 1-2 litres per animal; for lice repeat 14-18 days later.

DO NOT USE: ON CALVES OR COLTS UNDER 3 MONTHS OF AGE: ON SICK OR WEAK ANIMALS: ON DAIRY ANIMALS. DO NOT USE IN MILK ROOMS. DO NOT USE ON MEAT ANIMALS WITHIN 30 DAYS OF SLAUGHTER. DO NOT USE AS DIP-TREATMENT OF SHEEP WITHIN 60 DAYS OF SLAUGHTER.

TOBACCO: For wireworms apply 35 h in 200 litres of transplant water and use 2500 litres per hectare.

GREENHOUSE ORNAMENTALS AND FLOWERS: For aphids, thrips and white flies spray plants and soil at first sign of damage. Use 30-50 g per 200 square metres in sufficient water for good coverage.
