Tick and Flea Shampoo controls the dog and cat flea, the American dog tick and the brown dog tick as well as cleaning and deodorizing the animal.

DIRECTIONS: Wet animal thoroughly. Apply shampoo, working lather thoroughly down to skin from head to tail. Pay special attention to neck and hindquarters. Do not treat eyes, face, or genitals of pet. Allow lather to remain for 5-10 minutes. Rinse well and dry. Repeat treatments as necessary.

Consult a veterinarian before using on pregnant animals, sick animals, or animals under drug or other pesticide treatment. Do not use on nursing animals or animals under 8 weeks of age. Discontinue use if adverse effects are observed.

For effective flea and tick control, treatment of the pet should be combined with the sanitation of any area used by the pet. Vacuum floors, carpets, and furniture (discard vacuum bag after use) and wash the pet's bedding, living quarters, and surrounding areas. If pest problems persist, an insecticidal premise treatment may be required.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not contaminate food or feed. Keep away from animal's eyes and mouth. Wash hands after use. Do not use on nursing females or animals under

eight weeks of age. Do not use on sick animals. Do not use on animals under drug or pesticide treatment. For use on pregnant animals, consult a veterinarian.

DISPOSAL: Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills, contact the provincial regulatory agency or the manufacturer.

FIRST AID: If in eyes or on skin, flush with clean water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention. If accidentally swallowed, call poison control centre and obtain medical attention at once.
