Notification Change

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Apply Hose-spray Insecticide using the
hose-end applicator enclosed (attached). It will dilute this

concentrated insecticide for direct spraying of lawns, fruits, vegetables and ornamentals.

1. Read carefully the complete label for application instructions and precautions.
2. Shake well before applications. Connect spray-on applicator to garden hose. Remove bottle cap and attach bottle to applicator. Turn the on/off switch at the top of the applicator to the "off" position (sideways).
3. Turn water supply on the source.
4. When ready to spray, turn on/off switch to the "on" position (centre). For best results, hold sprayer and bottle level.
5. When spraying is completed, turn the on/off switch to the "off" position (sideways), then turn water off.
6. Disconnect hose from applicator, screw bottle cap on tightly, and store product in original container.

CAUTION: Rate of delivery of product will vary depending on water pressure, location, time-of-day, length and diameter of hose, etc. Complete contents of container (500 mL) can be sprayed in approximately 1.5 to 3 minutes.

GENERAL GARDEN USE: Spray when insects are noticed and repeat as needed; for carrot rust fly maggot and all fruit fly maggots, spray weekly between June 20th and July 31st. Spray to thoroughly wet foliage but not run off. Do not apply to a food crop within 10 days of harvest except for the following: tomato 1 day; cauliflower, broccoli, pepper, strawberry - 5 days; beans, cabbage, cucumber - 7 days; apple, pear, beet, potato - 14 days; grape and peach - 20 days.

FRUIT: FOR USE ON apple, apricot, cherry, grape, peach, pear, Plum, strawberry; TO CONTROL aphids, caterpillars, flea beetles, fruit flies, leafhoppers, leafminers, mealybugs, mites, scales, thrips.

VEGETABLES: FOR USE ON bean, beet, broccoli, cabbage, carrot, Cauliflower, celery, cucumber, lettuce, onion, parsnip, pepper, Potato, radish, spinach, tomato; TO CONTROL aphids, carrot rust flies, caterpillars, Colorado potato beetles, flea beetles, leafhoppers, leafminers, mites, root maggots, thrips.

CUTWORMS IN VEGETABLES: Apply 125 mL (3 of this bottle) evenly over 9.5 m² (100 sq.ft) of garden immediately before planting and rake into top 8 to 10 cm (3-4 inches) of soil.

FLOWERS AND ORNAMENTALS: FOR USE ON azalea, birch, boxwood, carnation, cedar, crabapple, fir, ivy, juniper, mum, oak,

pine, Rose, spruce, yew; TO CONTROL aphids, caterpillars, flea beetles, leafhoppers, leafminers, mealybugs, mites, pine shoot moths, rose chafer, scales, thrips.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Fatal if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. May irritate eyes, skin, nose and throat. Do not get into eyes. Avoid contact with skin, clothing and avoid inhalation of vapours or spray mist. Wear chemically resistant gloves when handling concentrated product. When applying wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes and socks and chemical resistant (e.g. rubber) gloves during handling, application and watering-in. Rinse gloves before removal. Do not treat areas greater than 450m² (5000ft²) in one day.

Wash thoroughly after handling.

Avoid contaminating food and feed. Do not allow others such as children or pets on treatment area during application or to reenter treated areas until spray has dried. This product is poisonous to bees, fish and wildlife; spray flowers in late evening only; do not contaminate water, ponds, etc.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and dispose of container with regular garbage.

FIRST AID: Product contains petroleum distillates, therefore, if swallowed, DO NOT induce vomiting. Obtain medical attention immediately taking this pesticide container with you or call a Poison Control Centre. If on skin, remove contaminated clothing wash thoroughly with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with water for 5 - 10 minutes and obtain medical attention. If inhaled, remove person to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration; obtain medical attention immediately. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. This product contains petroleum distillates.
