DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

GROTAN* FS Microbiocide is recommended for soluble and emulsifiable type aqueous metalworking fluids, such as emulsified petroleum oils, and formulations containing alcoholic fatty acid, sulfonated red oil, or naphthalene sulfonate. These fluids are usually prepared by diluting the product concentrates 1:40 to 1:60 with water. For the maintenance of a nonfouled system, add 290 mL per 10,000 L of emulsion or 290 mL – 1.45L every 8-12 weeks. For a noticeably fouled system use initial dosage range of 580 mL – 1.45 L followed by subsequent dosages depending upon the treatment level noted above. A higher dosage range and/or increased frequency of treatment may be required depending on rate of dilution of the preservative with makeup fluid, the nature and severity of contamination, level of control required, filtration effectiveness system design, etc.
