DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Apply BACTERGE to walls, floors and other inanimate non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks, tile, porcelain, and bedframes with a cloth, or mop so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required.

Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

DISINFECTION - to disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces, add 8 mL/L of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. At this use level, BACTERGE is also virucidal and fungicidal. Surfaces to be used for food contact must be rinsed with potable water prior to use.

SANITIZING - to sanitize non-porous, non-food contact surfaces, add 1.5 mL/L of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 60 seconds.

Instructions for Cleaning and Decontaminating Against HIV-1 on Surfaces and Objects Soiled with Blood or Bodily Fluids: This product is effective against HIV-1 (Human Immunodeficiency virus) in hard water up to 400 ppm (CaCO₃), and in the presence of organic soil (5% blood serum).

Personal Protection: When handling items soiled with blood or bodily fluids, wear disposable latex gloves, gowns, masks, and eye coverings.

Cleaning Procedure: Thoroughly clean blood or bodily fluids from surfaces before applying BACTERGE.

Contact Time: To kill HIV-1, apply BACTERGE at 32 mL for 4 Litres of water and allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes.

Disposal of Infectious Materials: Blood, body fluids, cleaning materials and clothing should be autoclaved and disposed of according to provincial and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. DANGER - CORROSIVE TO EYES. DO NOT GET IN EYES, ON SKIN OR ON CLOTHING. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. AVOID CONTAMINATION OF FOOD.

FIRST AID : In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician or poison control centre immediately.

DISPOSAL:

1. Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to treatment site.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.
