PLEASE READ THE LABEL BEFORE OPERATING THE UNIT.

Transonic is a solid-state electronic instrument that is very easy to operate, has no internal moving parts and will give years of trouble-free use repelling mice.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Plug the connector end of the AC Adapter cord into the rear of the unit; plug the wall plug end of the AC Adapter into any standard AC outlet. Then simply slide the switches to the positions that correspond to your specific requirements as follows:

- 1) Slide Power to the OFF Position.
- 2) Select QUIET. (Ultrasonic sound only).
- 3) Select MED. (Ultrasonic and some audible sound). Note that

this sound may bother some people near unit.

4) Select LOUD. (Ultrasonic with audible Low and Loud sounds). These loud sounds are recommended for use in attics, basements or outdoor areas away from people.

Note that the red L.E.D. (Light Emitting Diode) will flash when the unit is operating on any one of the switch positions when the power switch is On.

Ultrasonic sound waves are those which are above the range of normal human hearing.

Operate the unit 24 hours a day for at least two weeks.

For best results, use Transonic Cix continuously, occasionally moving the unit to a different location, or placing it at a slightly different angle or height.

RANGE (COVERAGE)

The distance sound carries is based upon frequency: High (ultrasonic or quiet) sounds dissipate rapidly, lower frequency sounds (Medium or Loud audible sound) carry farther.

On the QUIET setting, (Quiet ultrasonic sound only), maximum effective range is about 186 square meters (2,000 square feet).

On the MED setting, (Quiet ultrasonic and audible Medium sound), maximum effective range is about 233 square meters (2,500 square feet).

On the LOUD, outdoor setting, (Quiet ultrasonic with audible Medium and Loud sounds), maximum effective range is about 325 square meters (3,500 square feet).

Actual coverage is affected by room acoustics and sound absorbing materials (curtains, carpets, walls, ceilings). High frequency sounds cannot pass through walls or floors. Also, objects such as furniture, appliances and room dividers block high ultrasonic sounds casting acoustic shadows behind them.

ABOUT MICE

Mice are creatures of habit. They follow consistent routines, living in social groups or communities with others of their kind. They prefer to do their prowling and eating at night, but if hungry enough, they will venture out in daylight to find food. They seldom travel more than 45 meters (150 feet) from their

nest.

Mice have adapted perfectly to living with man. Throughout history, they have been responsible for the transmission of diseases and enormous food losses. All rodents have very well developed hearing that is sensitive to both sonic and ultrasonic noises.
