READ LABEL BEFORE USING

USE DIRECTIONS: DISINFECTION: Use at 16 mL per litre. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRD-10 at this level. This has been substantiated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test. At this level, the product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi. For best results, use CITRUS DISINFECTANT with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces. For heavy soil or organic matter, a pre-cleaning step is recommended.

SANITATION - If used for sanitation of previously cleaned food

equipment or food contact items, limit the level of active quaternaries to 200 ppm (5 mL per litre of water). No rinse required at this level. This product, when used on environmental, inanimate, hard surfaces at 16 mL per litre of water, is effective against influenza A2, Herpes Simplex, Adenovirus Type 2 and Vaccinia viruses.

DISPOSAL:

1. Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank.

4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
