PRECAUTION:

DIRECTIONS FOR GENERAL DISINFECTION:

Use TERAMINE NR in a dilution of 4-5 mL per litre of water. Thoroughly wet surfaces by wiping, mopping and scrubbing. Allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes, then remove excess liquid. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.®

All floors, walls, outer surfaces of equipment, locker rooms, lockers, exterior toilet bowl surfaces, toilet seats and washrooms should be disinfected with the recommended solution of TERAMINE NR. TERAMINE NR will not deteriorate upon storage or after being frozen. Do not dilute or store TERAMINE NR in iron, galvanized iron or in tin containers. Do not mix with soap.

MEAT AND FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS:

- 1) All foods must be covered or removed from areas to be cleaned.

- 2) Heavy accumulations of soil should be removed from surfaces or utensils.
- 3) Clean with an adequate detergent solution. Rinse with clear water.
- 4) Rinse or soak for at least two minutes with a final sanitizing solution of 2 mL TERAMINE NR per litre of water (200 p.p.m. quaternary ammonium compound).
- 5) Thoroughly drain of any excess sanitizing solution.

NOTE: The final sanitizing solution must not exceed 200 p.p.m. quaternary ammonium compound.

HAND OR BOOT DIP:

Add to reservoir at a rate of 10 mL per 5 litres of water to yield a 200 p.p.m. active Teramine NR solution. Check activity level frequently. Replace solution as required.

DISPOSAL:

1. Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills, contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.
