Maintains water in clean sanitary condition. Prevents algae growth in swimming pool. Algaecide is compatible with the usual water treatment chemicals. Algaecide is safe in pool dilutions, when used as directed.

DIRECTIONS:

1. If algae growth is heavy, add 500 mL of Algaecide for each 10,000 litres of water to kill growth of many algae species.
2. If algae growth is light or absent, use 100 mL of Algaecide for each 10,000 litres of water.
3. When existing growth is dead, as seen by change in colour of the algae, clean pool, draining and refilling if necessary, then add 100 mL of Algaecide per 10,000 litres of water.
4. Add 20 mL of Algaecide per 10,000 litres of water every five to ten days as necessary, to maintain between 2 and 5 parts per million of active ingredient. See serviceman for test kit.

NOTE:

Do not pre-mix with other pool chemicals - add directly to pool.

PRECAUTION:

Keep out of reach of children. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If in eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg white, gelatin solution, or if not available, drink large quantities of water. CALL A PHYSICIAN.
