DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 286 mL of Algicide per 10,000 L of pool water.
2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 143 mL per 10,000 L.
3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
4. For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 715 mL Algicide per 10,000 L.

PRECAUTIONS

Keep out of reach of children. - Harmful if swallowed. - Do not mix with any other chemical. - Rinse container thoroughly before discarding. Do not re-use. - To dispose of chemical, flush into sewer with large quantities of water.

FIRST AID
