#### DIRECTIONS

ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, SILVERFISH: Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush to baseboards, areas around waterpipes, cracks and crevices, surfaces beyond and around refrigerators, sinks, stoves, undersides of tabletops and shelving and similar areas where these insects nest or hide. Remove or cover all food and utensils before treatment.

CLOVER MITES: Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush to window and door frames and sills, along baseboards and the floor close to them. Pay particular attention to all cracks and crevices.

BROWN DOG TICKS, FLEAS: Thoroughly spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, animal sleeping quarters and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment.

CAUTION: Do NOT apply to pets or humans.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful liquid. May be absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid contamination of food and feed stuffs. Wash thoroughly after handling. Store in cool dry place.

COMBUSTIBLE: Do NOT spray near open flame. Do NOT smoke while using. Do NOT store near excessive heat.

FIRST AID
