DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL INFORMATION: RODENT REPELLENT is a specially formulated Thiram repellent to prevent RABBITS, MICE and DEER from causing injury to fruit trees and ornamental stock. Thiram repels by taste only and therefore some "teethmarks" may be noticed after application. When properly applied, RODENT REPELLENT will provide a white coat on the treated surfaces which may aid in the prevention of South-West injury.

STIR WELL BEFORE USING

FOR SPRAYING: Dilute RODENT REPELLENT with an equal volume of water and apply with a knapsack sprayer up to the point of run-off.

FOR BRUSHING: Do not dilute but brush RODENT REPELLENT directly onto the trees, with a large brush.

APPLICATION: Thoroughly cover trunk and branches as low as soil level to prevent mouse damage and, as high as rabbits and deer can reach under severe snow conditions. Best results are obtained after trees and shrubs have become dormant. The treated surfaces will withstand weathering if the repellent is applied on dry bark and the coating has dried before the temperature drops below freezing. If applied in early fall, repeat the treatment before snowfall. One thorough application in late fall gives protection until early spring.

1 litre of RODENT REPELLENT will treat approximately the following number of young trees, depending on age and size.

CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT: Clean spray equipment or brushes immediately after use by washing with soapy water before the material hardens.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Hazardous if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. After handling, wash thoroughly with soap and water before eating, drinking or smoking. DO NOT CONSUME alcoholic beverages immediately before or within 24 hours after working with this product. Avoid contamination of food or feed. Do not contaminate water supplies, irrigation ditches, ponds, lakes or streams.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with a finger or blunt object. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. If breathing affected, start artificial

respiration. Contact physician or Poison Control Centre or bring patient to nearest hospital taking this labelled container with you. In case of skin contact, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes and get medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: No specific antidote. Symptomatic measures. Thiram is chemically related to Antabuse, hence alcohol exposure is likely to be antagonistic.

STORAGE: Keep container closed to prevent hardening. DO NOT allow to freeze.

DISPOSAL: 1. Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank. 2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal. 3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use. 4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements. 5. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills contact the regional office of Conservation and Protection, Environment Canada.
