DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Spray infested surfaces only until wet.

For Cockroaches, Ants, Silverfish, Spiders, Crickets: Spray heavily in all cracks, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Also spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, etc. Use on other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required.

For Carpet Beetles: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks or closets and infested areas of shelvings. Repeat treatment as required.

For Fleas: Thoroughly apply spray as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not treat pets with this product.

PRECAUTIONS: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Wash after use. Cover fish bowls and remove pets for one hour after spraying. Remove or cover all exposed foods and cooking utensils before spraying. Do not spray closer than 1 M to fabric. Do not contaminate any body of water.

FIRST AID: This product contains petroleum distillates. If ingested, do not induce vomiting. Obtain medical attention immediately. If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and dispose of empty container in household garbage.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.
