DIRECTIONS: When threatened by a bear, place forefinger through hole in handle. Place thumb in front of safety clip and remove it by lifting up and back. Point nozzle directly toward bear's face. Depress actuator tab for a burst of spray to a maximum range of 8 metres. Move away from area of discharge to avoid exposure to spray. Replace safety clip after use. Spray is most effective at close range.

PRECAUTIONS: Do not store in vehicle or above 50EC. Container may explode if heated. Avoid spraying near open flame, spark or while smoking. Consult with air carriers for regulations concerning air transport. Check guidelines with your local or provincial police departments before use of this product. Persons with respiratory problems or wearing contact lenses should not use this product. Avoid inhalation of spray. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Remove and discard contact lenses if exposed. Medical attention may be required if inhaled.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press valve to release all pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate. Reduce pressure to zero prior to disposal in accordance with provincial requirements. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the manufacturer.

FIRST AID: In case of contact with skin, eyes, or nose, flush thoroughly with water. Do not rub eyes. Symptoms should disappear in 45 minutes. If symptoms persist, call a physician or Poison Control Centre immediately. Capsaicin sprays have proven to be effective in repelling bears that approach closely. Use only as a last resort. There is no guaranteed method of responding to a bear encounter, since each encounter is unique. Strict attention to the advice of wildlife professionals on safety is advised. Use only in outdoor areas.

Recommend replacement after 3 years from date of purchase.
