DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

GROTAN* M - 15 is added to metalworking fluids at concentrations of 250 to 1500 mL per 1000 L (250 to 1500 ppm GROTAN* M -15). Ideally, this preservative should be dispensed into the use-dilution of the metalworking fluid by a metering pump and uniformity dispersed throughout the system. For assistance or advice, contact Gray Products Technical Service Laboratory.

PRECAUTIONS:
