DIRECTIONS FOR INDOOR USE: Remove pets, birds and fish bowls. Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one can for each 150 cubic metres of unobstructed area.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Can be used manually or valve can be locked in open position. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, depress valve lever down firmly until it clicks and stays depressed. For best results, first spray distant rooms manually spraying towards ceiling, 4 to 6 seconds is ample for average (3m x 3m x 3m) room. Also spray into cracks and

crevices. Place can on stand or table in centre of 150 cubic metre of unobstructed area, then lock valve open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for 2 hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and ventilate for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in 2 weeks or when necessary. This formulation will kill exposed insects only and has no residual control activity.

CAUTION: Do not use in dwellings or in food storage, handling or service establishments as a total release bomb with valve locked open.

FOR OUTDOOR AND GARDEN USE: Spray with valve in manual position. For bugs on such plants as Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Delphiniums, Gladioli, Irises, Marigolds, Petunias, Roses and Snapdragons. Also for bugs on evergreens and small ornamental deciduous trees, shrubs and vines. For best results, spray in evening, or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use slow, sweeping motion. Keep can 45 cm from plants. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray rows at the rate of 30 cm per second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat when needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray garden when temperature exceeds 32 deg.C.

PRECAUTION: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Exposure to prolonged sunlight or other sources of heat may cause bursting. Do not throw into fire or incinerator or store at temperatures above 50 deg. C. Do not spray on walls, composition tile or plastic. So not spray over exposed foods. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. If on skin, wash with soap and water. If in eyes, rinse with water. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.
