#### PRECAUTIONS

- 1. KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.
- 2. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. May cause irritation.

TREATMENT STAGE: 3-leaf to flag leaf (shot blade) stage of crop, prior to head emergence and when weeds are less than 10 cm across or high, before the crop canopy closes. See EXPRESS label for

details on wild buckwheat and Canada thistle suppression.

- 2. Add 2,4-D Ester 700 L.V. When EXPRESS is used, add to the spray tank before the 2,4-D Ester 700 L.V. Add the surfactant last. See EXPRESS label for full details of mixing.
- 3. Complete filling the tank with water while maintaining continuous agitation.
- 4. Use 60 240 litres of water per hectare unless otherwise specified on EXPRESS label.
- 5. Do not exceed 275 kPa pressure.
