INTRODUCTION:

Talcord is a highly active insecticide which works by contact or stomach action. It is recommended for use against certain insect pests that attack sweet corn, cabbage, cauliflower, Brussels sprouts and broccoli. Refer to Directions for rates and insect pests controlled.

DIRECTIONS:

Ground Application Only

CROP	INSECT	DOSAGE	USE INSTRUCTION
Sweet corn	European corn borer; Corn earworm	275 - 350 mL/ha 300 - 400 L of water per ha. Use a boom and nozzle arrangement that ensures thorough spray coverage (1 L treats 2.9 - 3.6 ha).	Use the higher rate when severe insect pressure is anticipated. Spray not later than when first feeding is seen on the foliage. For second brood borers in late plantings, apply before tassels show. For control of corn earworm, direct spray to ensure coverage of ears and silks. For the number and timing of repeat applications, follow the customary spray schedule in your region. Consult the provincial spray calendar.
Allow 1 day between the last treatment and harvest.			
Cabbage, Cauliflower, Brussels Sprouts and Broccoli	Imported cabbage worm; Cabbage looper and Diamond back moth	90 - 175 mL in 300 - 500 L of water per ha. (1 L treats 5.7 - 11.1 ha).	Begin treatment when insects or signs of insect feeding appear. Repeat every 10 days or as necessary. Use the high rate for severe infestations.
Allow 3 days between the last treatment and harvest on cabbage, cauliflower and Brussels sprouts and 7 days on broccoli.			

USE LIMITATIONS:

APPLY USING GROUND EQUIPMENT ONLY. Do not apply by aircraft. This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not apply where streams, lakes, ponds or bodies of water used by livestock or for domestic purposes may be contaminated. Do not apply within 15 meters of fishery productive bodies of water or waterfowl habitats. Do not contaminate any body of water during filling or rinsing operations.

CAUTION:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Severely irritating to eyes. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or mouth. Avoid breathing the spray mist. Wash thoroughly

Rinse empty bottle 3 times with fresh water, disposing of the washings in the spray tank. Rinsed empty containers should be broken or crushed and disposed of in normal garbage.
