READ LABEL BEFORE USING

No prebaiting required - just use as suggested. Ditchling BAIT BLOCKS Rodenticide contains a select, choice combination of taste-tempting (to Norway & Roof Rats and House Mice) ingredients blended with a high-potency anticoagulant into a uniform standard, ready-to-use rodenticide.

DIRECTIONS: Snap-off Ditchling BAIT BLOCKS into the handy marked squares and place in protected areas where Rats and Mice are known to feed, water, run or exist. Ditchling BAIT BLOCKS will do the rest:

RATS: Place 2 to 6 squares (100-500 gms) in each infested area.

MICE: Place 1 square every 2 to 3 meters in infested areas.

KEEP TREATED AREAS WELL SUPPLIED. Continuous feeding from 5 to 14 days should give control. Ditchling BAIT BLOCKS should be available to rodents until complete lack of feeding is noticed. Never allow the treated areas to remain empty for over 48 hours.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Keep from pets and domestic animals. Do not expose in areas accessible to dogs unless placed in wire baskets within protected bait stations.

FIRST AID: If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes. If on skin, wash with soap and water. If swallowed, give patient one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with a finger or blunt object; repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Contact a physician or Poison Control Centre immediately.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Diphacinone is an anticoagulant. Vitamin K1, in the form of intravenous, intramuscular or subcutaneous injections, or by oral ingestion is suggested remedial treatment for anticoagulant poisoning. The severity of the case measured by establishing prolonged prothrombin times(P.T.) will determine appropriate therapy. Monitoring P.T. will indicate the necessity of repeated treatments.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of empty container by placing in household garbage.

Rodent Disposal: Dispose of dead rodents in garbage or by burying.
